AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution congratulating the Northeast High School Boys Basketball team for winning the Class 4A Boys Basketball State Championship; commending them for winning it twice during this century; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Oklahoma City's Northeast High School Boys Basketball Team Head Coach Phil Ingersoll had already won three state championships at Douglass High School before coming to Northeast High School four years ago. He coached the "maroon and grey" Vikings to the 2002 Title but because of last year's budget cuts, his position at Northeast was cut and not restored until July 22, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the five seniors on the Viking's team have played for Coach Ingersoll during his entire tenure at Northeast High School. Four seasons ago, when the coach and the present-day seniors started, the basketball program was badly in need of help.
