AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution commending Lacey Jones upon winning the State Class 4A High School Golf Championship; congratulating her for winning the title for four consecutive years; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, on Thursday, May 6, 2004, Lake Hefner's South Golf Course hosted the final round of the State Class 4A High School Golf tournament; and

WHEREAS, a crowd of 45 people, composed of family, friends, and classmates, who drove up to five hours to be present at the event, eagerly followed and cheered Idabel High School senior Lacey Jones as she successfully sought to become Oklahoma's first individual four-time state high school golf champion. Until now three girls and three boys have been three-time champions; and

WHEREAS, Idabel High School Senior Lacey Jones had a cumulative score of 136 – the best she has ever shot in a 36-hole event – to win the state championship by a 14-stroke advantage over her nearest competitor; and

WHEREAS, Lacy Jones has signed a National Letter of Intent with Southern Nazarene University in Bethany, Oklahoma, where she will be coached by Todd Selders.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 49TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate commends Idabel High School senior Lacey Jones for winning the State Class 4A High School Golf Championship.

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates Lacey Jones upon becoming Oklahoma's first individual four-time state champion in high school golf.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to Lacey Jones; her mother, Tanya Jones; her grandfather, Mike Murphy; Idabel High School Coach, Rich Impson; and Idabel High School Athletic Director, Bruce Hill.
