First Regular Session of the Forty-ninth Legislature of the State of Oklahoma

Seventh Legislative Day, Tuesday, February 11, 2003

SB 8 – By Wilkerson of the Senate and Roberts of the House.

An Act relating to retirement; exempting membership for certain members of the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System; allowing certain directors to make an election; providing for treatment of retirement status upon making election; restating limitation on certain benefits; preventing future service credit accumulation for certain members; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.
