AMENDMENT NO. 1. strike the stricken title, enacting clause and
entire bill and insert

"[health care for the indigent and uninsured in the
Tulsa Metropolitan Service Area - appropriation -
legislative intent - noncodification - effective
date -
emergency]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

It is the intent of the Legislature that the Community Hospitals
Authority conduct a formal study of issues consistent with the
purposes of the Community Hospitals Authority. The purpose of this
study shall relate to the current status of and make recommendations
for the future of the delivery and efficiency of medical services
across northeastern Oklahoma with a particular focus on the Oklahoma
State University College of Osteopathic Medicine and the University
of Oklahoma College of Medicine (Tulsa) and the delivery of care to
the indigent, underserved, and nonindigent populations.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2005.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force and after its passage and approval."
