An Act relating to public safety * * * * driver licenses * * * * financial responsibility * * * * accidents and accident reports; modifying time requirement for submission of certain information; modifying statutory references * * * * modifying requirements for driving on roadways laned for traffic; modifying definition of certain phrase; modifying merge requirements * * * * seizure of driver license; providing statutory references; deleting statutory references; modifying scope of hearing issues; repealing 47 O.S. 2001, Section 1-136.1, which relates to definition of motorized bicycle; and declaring an emergency.

- AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 3, line 32, strike the language "national criminal history records search"
- AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 4, line 2, after the stricken word "Investigation" and before the word "which" insert new language "security threat assessment performed by the Transportation Security Administration of the Department of Homeland Security as required by and pursuant to 49 C.F.R., Part 1572,"
- AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 5, line 21, delete the new language "national" strike the language "criminal history" and delete the new language "records search"
- AMENDMENT NO. 4. Page 5, line 23, after the stricken word "Investigation" and before the word "which" insert new language "security threat assessment performed by the Transportation Security Administration of the Department of Homeland Security as required by and pursuant to 49 C.F.R., Part 1572,"
- AMENDMENT NO. 5. Page 13, line 1, through Page 15, line 27, delete all of Section 4

and renumber subsequent sections
- AMENDMENT NO. 6. Page 1, strike the title to read

"[driver licenses - criminal history records search -
roadways - time limitations - repealing -
emergency]"
