An Act relating to criminal procedure; amending 22 O.S. 2001, Sections 60.4, as last amended by Section 15, Chapter 348, O.S.L. 2005 and 60.6, as last amended by Section 16, Chapter 348, O.S.L. 2005 (22 O.S. Supp. 2005, Sections 60.4 and 60.6), which relate to Protection from Domestic Abuse Act; authorizing use of certain device; requiring collection of fee by court clerk; expanding scope of penalties for violation of certain orders; requiring collection of fee by court clerk; modifying liability exemptions; and providing an effective date.

AMENDMENT NO. 1: Page 4, line 6, after the period and before the word "court" delete the word "The" and insert the language

"Upon a finding by the court that a defendant poses a serious threat to the victim or a member of the immediate family of the victim, the"

and on Page 4, line 7 through line 9, after the word "device" and through the word "fees" delete all language and insert the language

". A defendant ordered to be placed on an active global position system monitoring device shall pay all supervision fees. The court shall not order the defendant to be placed on an active global position system monitoring device unless the court first determines that the defendant is financially able to pay the supervision fees"

and on Page 8, line 26, after the word "court" and before the word "may" insert the language

", upon a finding that the defendant poses a serious threat to the victim or a member of the immediate family of the victim,"

and on Page 8, line 27 through line 29, after the word "device" and through the word "fees" delete all language and insert the language

". Any defendant ordered to be placed on an active global position system monitoring device shall pay all supervision fees. The court shall not order the defendant to be placed on an active global position system monitoring device unless the court first determines that the defendant is financially able to pay the supervision fees"

AMENDMENT NO. 2: Page 1, strike the title to read

"[ criminal procedures - Protection from Domestic Abuse  
Act - collection of fee -  
effective date ]"

and when the title is restored amend the title to conform
