An Act relating to children; \* \* \* \* creating the Kelsey Smith-Briggs Child Protection Reform Act; amending 10 O.S. 2001, Section 601.6, which relates to the Office of Juvenile System Oversight; \* \* \* \* requiring certain information be included on form; modifying time limitations for notice of appeal; requiring appeal by district attorney upon request by certain person; \* \* \* \* requiring the Department of Human Services to establish a performance-based incentive compensation program for certain employees; \* \* \* \* authorizing travel reimbursement; providing for meetings, quorum and record-keeping; requiring progress reports; providing staff to assist Committee; authorizing judge of district court to request an investigation under certain circumstances; \* \* \* \* providing for codification; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.
