CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the University Hospitals Authority; making an appropriation to the University Hospitals Authority; stating purpose; imposing restriction upon expenditure of appropriation based upon certain judicial proceeding; providing lapse date; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the University Hospitals Authority from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, the sum of Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the University Hospitals Authority by Section 1 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1093 of the 1st Session of the 50th Oklahoma Legislature with respect to acquisition and improvement of real property for the benefit of a qualified medical research entity.

SECTION 2. The monies appropriated by Section 1 of this act shall not be expended by the University Hospitals Authority until the Oklahoma Supreme Court renders an opinion that validates the lease and any other applicable agreement between the University

Hospitals Authority and a qualified medical research entity as provided by Section 1 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1093 of the 1st Session of the 50th Oklahoma Legislature. Such expenditures shall not be made until a final decision is reached, including any possible period for rehearing.

SECTION 3. The appropriation made by Section 1 of this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the effective date of this act.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2005.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
