2ND CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to intoxicating substances;
prohibiting certain acts; providing penalty;
providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8.2 of Title 37, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No person shall knowingly and willfully permit any individual
under twenty-one (21) years of age who is an invitee of said person
in the person's residence, any building, structure, or room owned,
occupied, leased or otherwise procured by the person or on any land
owned, occupied, leased or otherwise procured by the person, to
possess or consume any alcoholic beverage as defined by Section 506
of Title 37 of the Oklahoma Statutes, any controlled dangerous
substance as defined in the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances
Act, or any combination thereof, in such place.

B. Any person who violates this section, and such actions cause
the death of a person, shall be guilty of a felony, punishable by
imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for not
more than five (5) years, a fine of not less than Two Thousand Five

Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) nor more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
