COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; requiring the Oklahoma Transportation Authority to request certain study; requiring copies of results of study be submitted to certain persons; and providing for codification.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1915 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Transportation Authority, in accordance with the appropriate rules or laws, shall request an environmental impact study be conducted on the area that would encompass an extension of the Kilpatrick Turnpike through Canadian County and connecting to Interstate 35. The request shall be made by November 1, 2005.

B. A copy of the report or any findings that are a result of the environmental impact study shall be submitted within thirty (30) days of receipt by the Authority to the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.
