COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to counties; amending 19 O.S. 2001, Section 1403, which relates to County Budget Act; requiring certain counties to comply with act; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2001, Section 1403, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1403. ~~This~~ A. Except as otherwise provided by subsection B of this section, this act shall apply to any county which by resolution of the governing body elects to come under and comply with all its provisions and requirements. Once a county has selected the County Budget Act to govern its budget procedures, the provisions of this act shall take precedence over any other state laws applicable to county budgets, except as may be provided otherwise in this act and supersede any conflicting laws. Any action of a county governing body to implement, rescind or repeal the application of this act shall be effective as of the beginning or end of a budget year pursuant to this act.

B. In counties with a population in excess of five hundred fifty thousand (550,000) according to the latest Federal Decennial Census, the governing bodies shall be subject to and comply with the provisions of the County Budget Act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2005.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
