BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 29, O.S.L. 2005
(70 O.S. Supp. 2005, Section 11-103.9), is amended to read as
follows:

Section 11-103.9 A. Beginning with the 2006-2007 school year,
the State Board of Education shall require, as a condition of
accreditation, that school districts provide to all students
physical education programs which may include athletics.

B. Beginning with the 2006-2007 school year, the State Board of
Education shall require, as a condition of accreditation, that
public elementary schools provide instruction, for students in full-
day kindergarten and grades one through five, in physical education
or exercise programs for a minimum of an average of sixty (60)
minutes each week.

C. Beginning with the 2007-2008 school year, the State Board of
Education shall recommend that public schools provide instruction,
for students in grades six through eight, in physical education or

exercise programs for a minimum of an average of sixty (60) minutes each week.

D. The State Board of Education shall disseminate information to each school district on the benefits of physical education programs and shall strongly encourage districts to provide physical education instruction to students in grades six through twelve.

~~D.~~ E. Instruction in physical education required in this section shall be aligned with the Priority Academic Student Skills as adopted by the State Board of Education.

~~E.~~ F. The State Board of Education shall adopt rules to implement the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2001, Section 24-105, is amended to read as follows:

Section 24-105. A. The board of education of each school district shall have full power and authority to regulate, control or prohibit any fraternity, sorority, secret society, club or group composed in whole or in part of ~~pupils~~ students enrolled in the ~~elementary and high schools of the~~ school district if it deems it advisable and ~~to~~ in the best interest of the school program to do so.

B. Each board of education shall adopt policies and procedures to annually notify parents and guardians of students about clubs and organizations sponsored by or under the direction and control of the school. The annual notification about clubs and organizations may be by means of the student handbook or other appropriate method and shall include, but is not limited to, the following information about each club or organization:

1. Name;
2. Mission or purpose;
3. Name of the faculty advisor; and
4. Description of past and planned activities, including any activities reasonably related to the club or organization.

Activities shall not include competitive interscholastic activities or events.

C. If clubs or organizations are created or formed after the annual notification is distributed, the school district shall send additional notification to the parents and guardians containing information about the additional clubs or organizations consistent with the requirements set forth in subsection B of this section.

D. The policy adopted by each board of education shall provide parents and guardians of students with an opportunity to withhold permission for a student to join or participate in one or more clubs or organizations.

E. For purposes of this section:

1. "Clubs and organizations" means any club or organization comprised of students who organize and meet for common goals, objectives, or purposes and that are directly under the sponsorship, direction and control of the school; and

2. "Competitive interscholastic activity or event" means activities held under the auspices or sponsorship of a school district that involve students enrolled in that school district competing against individual or groups of students representing other school districts.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
