SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7607 of Title 10, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

State beneficiary public trusts created pursuant to the provisions of the Lead-Impacted Communities Relocation Assistance Act, shall consist of, but not be limited to, members appointed by the Governor who shall represent municipal and county governments and the school districts within the boundaries of federal Superfund sites. Such trusts may be made up of any number of members the Governor deems necessary to implement the provisions of the Lead-Impacted Communities Relocation Assistance Act.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
