COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating a portion of State Highway 51 as the "Mannford Expressway"; designating a bridge on U.S. Highway 183 as the "Joe M. Morgan Memorial Bridge"; directing the Department of Transportation to place suitable permanent markers on the structures bearing the designations; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1674 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

State Highway 51, from a point one mile east of its intersection with State Highway 151, also known as the "Keystone Dam Road", west to its intersection with State Highway 48 in Mannford, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the "Mannford Expressway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing the designation.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1675 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge that crosses the Washita River on U.S. Highway 183 near Clinton, Oklahoma in Custer County shall be designated as the "Joe M. Morgan Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation

shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the bridge bearing that name.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
