BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, the Board of Medicolegal Investigations shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Board of Medicolegal Investigations by law shall be set by the Board. The salary of the Chief Medical Examiner shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006. The Board of Medicolegal Investigations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital, intra-agency payments and special projects, except as may

be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 3. Of the total number of full-time-equivalent employees authorized for the Board of Medicolegal Investigations, two (2.0) shall be employed contingent upon sufficient federal grant funding to support them.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2005.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
