An Act relating to career and technology education; making an appropriation; stating purpose; amending Section 4, Chapter 475, O.S.L. 2004, which relates to budget limits; increasing budget limits; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Career and Technology Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Board of Career and Technology Education by law.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 4, Chapter 475, O.S.L. 2004, is amended to read as follows:

Section 4. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005, the State Board of Career and Technology Education shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
