An Act relating to state government; declaring certain policies as null and void; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3119 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any nondiscrimination policy based on sexual preference that is developed and implemented by any agency or governmental entity of this state shall be null and void.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
