

ENGROSSED HOUSE

An Act relating to children; prohibiting the Developmental Disabilities Services Division of the Department of Human Services from imposing certain requirements; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1411.3 of Title 10, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Developmental Disabilities Services Division of the Department of Human Services is prohibited from imposing any requirements on service providers that would result in additional costs as identified through data provided in uniform cost reports, or a reduction in the amount of funding that is available to such providers. This section is not applicable to requirements established pursuant to state or federal law or regulations.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
