

ENGROSSED HOUSE

An Act relating to state government; exempting certain temporary employees of the Department of Environmental Quality from full-time-equivalency limitations; limiting temporary full-time-equivalency employees to certain percentage of total full-time-equivalency employee limit; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-5.13A of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

With the exception of temporary employees hired through temporary personnel services agencies, temporary employees of the Department of Environmental Quality shall not apply against any full-time-equivalency employee limitation imposed by law on the Department. The equivalency figure for temporary employees and students in the unclassified service shall not exceed eight percent (8%) of the total full-time-equivalent employee limit established for the Department.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2006.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
