A Concurrent Resolution designating the Long Branch Creek Bridge on U.S. Highway 70 as the Faye Moore Bridge; directing the Oklahoma Department of Transportation to place permanent markers; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Faye Moore is a fine, upstanding citizen who resides in the town of Ringling in Jefferson County and has for a lifetime; and

WHEREAS, Faye Moore is tireless in trying to ensure that her fellow neighbors and other citizens of this state enjoy a better quality of life by promoting public safety through her efforts to make U.S. Highway 70 in Jefferson County a safe roadway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 50TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Long Branch Creek Bridge, located 1.8 miles east of Ringling on U.S. Highway 70 in Jefferson County, be designated as the "Faye Moore Bridge".

THAT the Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall cause permanent suitable markers to be placed upon the bridge bearing the name.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Secretary of Transportation, the Director of the Department of Transportation, to members of the State Transportation Commission, and to Faye Moore.
