CONCURRENT
RESOLUTION NO. 1052

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A Concurrent Resolution relating to rules of the Oklahoma Board of Chiropractic Examiners; amending proposed amendment to OAC 140:15-9, which relates to chiropractic specialties; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 250.2 and 308 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature reserves the right to designate the method for rule promulgation, establish policy, approve, delay, suspend, veto, or amend the implementation of any rule or proposed rule while under review by the Legislature, determine that a rule is not consistent with legislative intent, and disapprove any rule or any portion thereof at any time, and the Legislature may, by concurrent resolution, disapprove any rule or amendment to a rule which has been transmitted for legislative review; and

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2006, the Oklahoma Board of Chiropractic Examiners submitted to the Legislature for its review a proposed amendment to OAC 140:15-9, which relates to chiropractic specialties; and

WHEREAS, the rules were transmitted to the Speaker of the House of Representatives during the previous interim; therefore, pursuant to subsection E of Section 308 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the thirty-legislative-day review period has not yet run; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Legislature to amend Section 1 of the proposed amendment to OAC 140:15-9-1 by correcting a technical error, which relates to oversight authority of

chiropractic specialties, submitted by the Oklahoma Board of Chiropractic Examiners, striking the phrase "post doctoral" and adding the phrase "post-doctorate Diplomate"; striking the phrase "post doctoral chiropractic specialty" and adding the phrase "post-doctorate Diplomate"; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Legislature to amend Section 2 of the proposed amendment to OAC 140:15-9-2 by correcting a technical error, which relates to specialty register of chiropractic specialties, submitted by the Oklahoma Board of Chiropractic Examiners, striking the phrase "specialist or" and adding the phrase "post-doctorate Diplomate"; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Legislature to amend Section 4 of the proposed amendment to OAC 140:15-9-4 by correcting a technical error, which relates to initial registration requirements of chiropractic specialties, submitted by the Oklahoma Board of Chiropractic Examiners, striking the phrase "specialist" and adding the phrase "post-doctorate Diplomate"; to capitalize the term "Diplomate" as used twice in the section; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Legislature to amend Section 5 of the proposed amendment to OAC 140:15-9-5 by correcting a technical error, which relates to annual re-registration requirements of chiropractic specialties, submitted by the Oklahoma Board of Chiropractic Examiners, striking the phrase "specialist" and adding the phrase "post-doctorate Diplomate"; striking the phrase "specialty" and adding the phrase "post-doctorate Diplomate"; to capitalize the term "Diplomate"; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Legislature to amend Section 6 of the proposed amendment to OAC 140:15-9-6 by correcting a technical error, which relates to prohibited acts of chiropractic specialties, submitted by the Oklahoma Board of Chiropractic Examiners, striking the phrase "diplomate specialty" and adding the phrase "Diplomate"; striking the phrase "diplomate specialist" and

adding the phrase "Diplomate"; striking the phrase "specialty" and adding the phrase "post-doctorate Diplomate"; to add a hyphen (-) between the term post and doctorate; striking the phrase "chiropractic specialist" and adding the phrase "Diplomate".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 50TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Legislature hereby amends the proposed amendment to OAC 140:15-9.

THAT copies of this resolution shall be distributed to the Governor, the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Board of Chiropractic Examiners, and the editor of "The Oklahoma Register".
