A Concurrent Resolution commending the life of Don Reynolds; designating bridge at Interstate 40 and Sooner Road as the "Don Reynolds Memorial Bridge"; directing placement of permanent markers; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Don Reynolds was born in Inola, Oklahoma, in 1915, and moved to Del City, Oklahoma, in 1952 creating a loving home for his wife Lois and daughters Marilyn and Donna; and

WHEREAS, Don Reynolds served as Del City's first Business Manager from 1955 to 1959, prior to the establishment of the city manager/mayor form of government; and

WHEREAS, Don Reynolds served on the Del City Council from 1959 to 1963 and served as Mayor of Del City from 1964 to 1969; and

WHEREAS, Don Reynolds served as a Regent for Rose State College from 1971 to 2001, and upon his retirement, was recognized as the longest tenured regent for a junior college in the nation; and

WHEREAS, Don Reynolds worked in the banking industry from 1959 until his death; and

WHEREAS, Don Reynolds served as a Sunday School teacher at Sunnyslane Methodist Church of Del City for forty years; and

WHEREAS, Don Reynolds served the citizens of Del City for more than fifty years as a highly respected, well-loved individual; and

WHEREAS, Don Reynolds passed from this life of service in 2002 at the age of 82.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 50TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma Legislature commends the life and service given by Don Reynolds to Del City and the State of Oklahoma.

THAT the bridge located on Interstate 40 at Sooner Road be designated as the "Don Reynolds Memorial Bridge".

THAT the Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall cause permanent suitable markers to be placed upon the bridge bearing the name.

THAT copies of this resolution be dispatched to the Secretary of Transportation, to the Director of the Department of Transportation, to members of the State Transportation Commission, and to Marilyn Hodgkinson and Donna Miller, the daughters of Don Reynolds.
