BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2001, Section 7-204, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 7-204. A. All wildlife found in this state is the  
property of the state.

B. Prior to final enclosure of any tract of more than two (2)  
acres in size with a fence designed to or capable of confining deer  
or other wildlife, a drive must be made throughout the area to  
ensure that any wild whitetail or mule deer, elk, antelope, or other  
big game are not present on the area. Such drive must be made in  
the presence of designated Department of Wildlife Conservation  
employees and shall be to the satisfaction of such employees.

C. A violation of the provisions of subsection B of this  
section shall be a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of One Thousand  
Dollars (\$1,000.00) per acre for every acre enclosed in violation of  
this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
