BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1416 of Title 63, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1. The State Department of Health shall amend its Oklahoma  
Pandemic Influenza Management Plan to assume greater responsibility  
for adequate stockpiles of antiviral drugs and shall not rely solely  
upon the federal government to provide such supplies.

2. The Department shall request appropriate funding from the  
Legislature.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2006.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
