12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2001, Section 2-118, as  
14 last amended by Section 5, Chapter 248, O.S.L. 2005 (26 O.S. Supp.  
15 2005, Section 2-118), is amended to read as follows:

16 Section 2-118. A. The secretary of each county election board  
17 shall be paid an annual salary to be determined by the following  
18 schedule. However, the salary of a county election board secretary  
19 shall not fall below the level of the April 30, 2003, salary, and  
20 the salary of any person who is reappointed to the position of  
21 county election board secretary shall not fall below the salary  
22 received in the immediately preceding term, regardless of the number  
23 of active registered voters in the county. A county election board  
24 secretary serving on April 30, 2004, shall not receive a salary  
25 increase if said secretary is paid an amount greater than the salary  
26 indicated in this section according to the number of registered  
27 voters in said county. A county election board secretary shall not  
28 receive a salary increase while the county is under the  
29 administrative supervision of the State Election Board.

30 Beginning May 1, 2003, the annual salary, payable monthly shall  
31 be:

9 B. The salary and fringe benefits paid to each secretary shall  
10 be paid from county funds on a monthly basis and shall be reimbursed  
11 from funds appropriated by the Legislature for that purpose at a  
12 rate of not to exceed one hundred thirty-five percent (135%) of the  
13 above-specified salaries. Claims for said reimbursement shall be  
14 filed according to procedures prescribed by the Secretary of the  
15 State Election Board and approved by the Director of State Finance.  
16 Said claims for reimbursement shall only be paid for actual  
17 expenditures made by the county. The number of registered voters,  
18 for the purposes of this section, shall be determined by the number  
19 of registered voters, ~~excluding~~ including active and inactive  
20 voters, in the county on January 1, 1979, and every two (2) years  
21 thereafter.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
