BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-100b of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The State Board of Education shall develop a fitness assessment software program customized for Oklahoma schools that has the capability to track various measurements of student fitness, including body mass index, aerobic endurance, strength and flexibility. The software program shall have the capability of creating confidential reports for parents that include explanations of the data and suggestions for appropriate actions that may be taken to improve the fitness level of the student. The Board shall select a number of elementary school sites to pilot the software during the 2006-07 school year. Pilot sites shall test all students in grades three, four, and five.

Beginning with the 2007-08 school year, the Board shall recommend that each school district administer the assessment to each student enrolled in grades three, four, and five.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
