An Act relating to public finance; authorizing the Office of State Finance and the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority to enter certain agreement to develop certain information technology and telecommunications infrastructure and security facilities; authorizing use of certain funds; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 41.5w of Title 62, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Office of State Finance and the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority are authorized to enter into a multi-year agreement to jointly develop and construct facilities necessary for the administration of the state's information technology and telecommunications infrastructure and security. The Office of State Finance is authorized to use existing and future funds from fees, appropriations and federal funds, as necessary, to finance such facilities.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2006.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
