An Act relating to definitions; naming the nature center in Bernice State Park the Rick Littlefield Nature Center; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 98.10 of Title 25, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The nature center located in Bernice State Park, Bernice, Oklahoma, and on the shores of Grand Lake O' the Cherokees is hereby officially named the Rick Littlefield Nature Center.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2005.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
