BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 752B of Title 15, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A person who accepts a check for a consumer transaction shall
not write the following personal information on the check:

1. Driver license number;
2. Date of birth;
3. Social security number; or
4. Credit card number.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
