An Act relating to the Board of Medicolegal Investigations; requiring budgeting in certain categories and amounts; requiring performance measures; providing for the duties and compensation of employees; limiting salary of the Chief Medical Examiner; providing budgetary limitations; making certain full-time-equivalent employees contingent upon certain funding; providing lapse dates; and requiring and prohibiting certain budget practices.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007, the Board of Medicolegal Investigations shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

The agency shall develop out-come based performance measures for each budget category.

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the Board of Medicolegal Investigations by law shall be set by the Board. The salary of the Chief Medical Examiner shall not exceed One Hundred Eighty-five Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-five Dollars (\$185,955.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007. The Board of Medicolegal Investigations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007, shall be

subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 3. Of the total number of full-time-equivalent employees authorized for the Board of Medicolegal Investigations, two shall be employed contingent upon sufficient federal grant funding to support them.

SECTION 4. Appropriations made by Section 74 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 80XX of the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 50th Oklahoma Legislature, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007 (hereafter FY-07), or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008 (hereafter FY-08). Funds budgeted for FY-07 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2007, and must be expended by November 15, 2007. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2007, and not budgeted for FY-08, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-08 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2008. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2008, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-07, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-08, after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-07 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.
