A Concurrent Resolution praising the Glencoe High School Panthers boys basketball team for winning the Class B Boys State Basketball Championship; congratulating them for winning the first athletic championship in the school's history; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Glencoe High School in Payne County, Oklahoma, has an enrollment of less than 100 students. Head basketball coach Talby Justus is only in his second year in that position. His basketball team, the Panthers, like other schools in the Cimarron Valley Conference, stresses defense in preference to offense; and

WHEREAS, the sixth-ranked Glencoe Panthers defeated the fourth-ranked Fort Cobb-Broxtton team 39-24 to win the Class B Boys State Basketball Championship title on Saturday, March 4, 2006, at the State Fair Arena, in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The Glencoe Panthers finished the season with a 28-4 record, including state tournament victories over eighth-ranked Red Oak and eleventh-ranked Coyle, to earn the right to meet defending state champion Fort Cobb-Broxtton in the final game; and

WHEREAS, the 2006 play-off was the first time the Panthers participated in the state tournament since they lost to Fort Cobb-Broxtton in the title game in 2000. This is also the first athletic championship in the school's history.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 50TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature praises the Glencoe High School Panthers boys basketball team for winning the Class B Boys State Basketball Championship.

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature congratulates the Glencoe High School Panthers boys basketball team for winning the first athletic championship in the school's history.
