An Act relating to the Oklahoma House of Representatives; making an appropriation thereto; stating purpose; making appropriation nonfiscal; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma House of Representatives from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, the sum of Eight Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$850,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma House of Representatives by Section 2 of this act.

SECTION 2. The funds appropriated to the Oklahoma House of Representatives in Section 1 of this act shall be used by the Oklahoma House of Representatives for the purpose of conducting a study or studies regarding the operation and administration of services provided to the state's citizens by state agencies. The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall have authority to determine the nature and scope of the study or studies, as well as all other related matters pertaining to such study or studies.

SECTION 3. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2005.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
