An Act relating to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department; exempting certain appropriation from certain expenditure limitations; requiring that funds be included in budget work program; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The appropriation made by Enrolled House Bill No. 1001 of the 1st Session of the 50th Oklahoma Legislature shall be exempt from the expenditure limitations in Section 5 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1122 of the 1st Session of the 50th Oklahoma Legislature, provided that any such funds used for operations shall be included in the agency's budget work program.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2005.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
