An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;  
requiring transfer of certain funds; stating amount  
of funds to be transferred; stating purpose;  
providing an effective date; and declaring an  
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. Of the monies appropriated to the Department of Public Safety by Sections 1 and 2 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1158 of the 1st Session of the 50th Oklahoma Legislature, not more than Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Six Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$350,630.00) shall be transferred to the Oklahoma Climatological Survey, under the direction and supervision of the Board of Regents of the University of Oklahoma, for the use of the Survey to perform its duties as prescribed by law.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2005.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
