An Act relating to sunset; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Sections 3906, 3907, as amended by Section 3, Chapter 93, O.S.L. 2004 and 3917 (74 O.S. Supp. 2004, Section 3907), which relate to the Oklahoma Sunset Law; modifying termination date for the 2005 omnibus sunset list; adding entity to the list; changing sunset review requirement for certain entities; and modifying allowable termination date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 3906, is amended to read as follows:

Section 3906. The following statutory entities and their successors shall be terminated on July 1, ~~2005~~ 2011, and all powers, duties and functions shall be abolished one (1) year thereafter:

~~1. State Board of Registration for Foresters as created by Section 1203 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes;~~

~~2.~~ Polygraph Examiners Board as created by Section 1455 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

~~3.~~ 2. State Board of Osteopathic Examiners as created by Section 624 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes; ~~and~~

~~4.~~ 3. Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners as created by Section 137 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

4. Oklahoma Professional Boxing Commission as created by Section 604.1 of Title 3A of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 3907, as amended by Section 3, Chapter 93, O.S.L. 2004 (74 O.S. Supp. 2004, Section 3907), is amended to read as follows:

Section 3907. The following statutory entities and their successors shall be terminated on July 1, 2006, and all powers, duties and functions shall be abolished one (1) year thereafter:

1. Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology as created by Section 1607 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

2. State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners as created by Section 698.3 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

3. Board of Tests for Alcohol and Drug Influence as created by Section 759 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

4. State Anatomical Board as created by Section 91 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

5. Oklahoma State Board of Examiners for Nursing Home Administrators as created by Section 330.52 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

6. Oklahoma Peanut Commission as created by Section 18-52 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

7. Sheep and Wool Utilization, Research and Market Development Commission as created by Section 18-181 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

8. Oklahoma Wheat Utilization, Research and Market Development Commission as created by Section 18-301 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

9. Board of Examiners in Optometry as created by Section 582 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

10. State Capitol Preservation Commission as created by Section 4102 of this title;

11. Commission on County Government Personnel Education and Training as created by Section 130.1 of Title 19 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

12. Oklahoma Climatological Survey as created by Section 245 of this title;

13. The State Board of Licensed Social Workers as created by Section 1253 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

14. Child Death Review Board as created by Section 1150.2 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

15. State Agency Review Committee as created by Section 7005 of this title;

16. The Wellness Council as created by Section 1382 of this title;

17. Oklahoma Liquefied Petroleum Gas Research, Marketing and Safety Commission as created by Section 420.22 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes; ~~and~~

18. Board of Chiropractic Examiners as created by Section 161.4 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

19. State Board of Registration for Foresters as created by Section 1203 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 3917, is amended to read as follows:

Section 3917. A. Any statutory entity enumerated in the Oklahoma Sunset Law shall, if re-created, be placed in this act to be terminated or re-created not more than six (6) years thereafter.

B. The Oklahoma Department of Libraries shall monitor actions of the State Legislature and maintain a list of all agencies, boards, commissions, committees or other entities created or authorized by law, and all entities created by a Governor's Executive Order. The updated list shall be provided to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma Senate, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, and the chairs of the appropriate House or Senate sunset committee within thirty (30) days after sine die adjournment of each legislative session.
