An Act relating to criminal procedure; amending 22
O.S. 2001, Section 984.2, which relates to disclosure
of certain victim information; expanding scope of
disclosure provision; and providing an effective
date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 22 O.S. 2001, Section 984.2, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 984.2 The court, upon the request of a victim, witness,
or the district attorney, may order that the ~~victim's~~ address,
telephone number, place of employment, or other personal information
of the victim or witness shall not be disclosed in any law
enforcement record or any court document, other than the transcript
of a court proceeding, if it is determined by the court to be
necessary to protect the victim, witness, or immediate family of the
victim or witness from harassment or physical harm and if the court
determines that the information is immaterial to the defense.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
