WHEREAS, the professional public safety telecommunicator is that vital link between the citizen or victim and the public safety provider who may apprehend a criminal, save their possessions from fire, save their life or the life of a loved one; and

WHEREAS, the men and women of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol who perform telecommunications duties serve as an indispensable link between our troopers, the public and vital support services; and

WHEREAS, too often the importance of our telecommunications personnel goes unrecognized and their services are taken for granted; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety Communications Officers should be appropriately recognized for their valuable contributions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 50TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma Legislature offers its sincere and heartfelt gratitude and commendation to the men and women who serve as Communications Officers within the thirteen Department of Public Safety Troop Headquarters across Oklahoma.

THAT the week of April 10-16, 2005 shall be proclaimed as "National Public Safety Telecommunicator's Week" across the state of Oklahoma.
