A Concurrent Resolution relating to rules of the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry; waiving the thirty-legislative-day review period for proposed permanent rule OAC 35:30-17-24.1 that relates to application of herbicides containing particular active ingredients to agricultural lands; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, pursuant to subparagraph b of paragraph 2 of subsection B of Section 308 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature may, by concurrent resolution, waive the thirty-legislative-day review period for any rule that has been transmitted for legislative review; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2006, the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry submitted to the Legislature for its review proposed permanent rule OAC 35:30-17-24.1 that relates to application of herbicides containing particular active ingredients to agricultural lands; and

WHEREAS, herbicides containing particular active ingredients can be harmful to cotton, grapes, and other sensitive crops; and

WHEREAS, rules to control the application of herbicides to agricultural lands are important to the economic viability of agriculture in the State of Oklahoma, and should be promulgated expeditiously.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 50TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Legislature hereby waives the thirty-legislative-day review period for proposed permanent rule OAC 35:30-17-24.1.

THAT copies of this resolution shall be distributed to the Governor, the Commissioner of Agriculture, and the Editor of "The Oklahoma Register".
