WHEREAS, Dr. Ronald O. Gilcher, MD, FACP, began his medical career at the Central Blood Bank of Pittsburg where he was coinventor of the surgical cell salvage device; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Gilcher performed his first therapeutic plasma exchange on a dying patient using only a syringe in which he spent all night manually exchanging plasma on the patient; and

WHEREAS, the therapeutic plasma exchange was successful and led Dr. Gilcher to work with several companies to develop and build apheresis machines; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Gilcher became director of the fledgling Oklahoma Blood Institute in 1979; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Gilcher has transformed the Oklahoma Blood Institute into the nation's sixth largest community blood center which has been on the cutting edge of blood center innovation and blood supply safety for 25 years; and

WHEREAS, during his long and distinguished career, Dr. Gilcher has led the charge for increased safety in the nation's blood supply and Oklahomans have benefited from Dr. Gilcher's commitment by having the safest and highest quality blood supply in the nation; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Gilcher is a visionary with equal enthusiasm for learning and teaching and has authored hundreds of published abstracts and articles and has given countless speeches around the globe.
