A Resolution praising the University of Oklahoma Men's Gymnastics Team on their outstanding season; acknowledging their accomplishments; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the University of Oklahoma Men's Gymnastics Team won its sixth national NCAA title in 2005, placing them in the top four in the NCAA record books for the total number of national championships; and

WHEREAS, team member David Henderson became OU's 18th all-time individual national champion by winning the still rings; and

WHEREAS, the Sooners achieved a record of 21 and 2; had a school-record 13 All-Americans; were conference champions for the sixth time with three individual conference champions: David Henderson on vault, Jamie Henderson on pommel horse, and Jonathan Horton on rings; and placed Jonathan Horton on the U.S. Men's Senior National Team; and

WHEREAS, three of those national titles have come in the last four years; and

WHEREAS, Head Coach Mark Williams is the NCAA coach of the year for the third time and holds a career record of 138 and 13.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 50TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
