A Resolution honoring Dr. Paul G. Risser, Chancellor for Higher Education for his many contributions to the State of Oklahoma; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Dr. Paul G. Risser, a native of Blackwell, Oklahoma, has served as Chancellor for Higher Education for three years; and

WHEREAS, Chancellor Risser holds a doctorate in botany and soils and, as a distinguished research scientist, has published more than 100 scientific papers and six books; and

WHEREAS, Chancellor Risser has served as president of three prestigious scientific organizations and served as chair of three committees of the National Academies of Science including, at present, the committee studying the environmental impacts of wind energy; and

WHEREAS, Chancellor Risser serves as chair of the Science Committee of the Smithsonian National History Museum in Washington, D.C.; and

WHEREAS, Chancellor Risser has provided leadership in Oklahoma and nationally by serving on many boards and committees including the Governor's Council on Economic and Workforce Development, the Achieving Classroom Excellence Task Force, the State Higher

Education Executive Officers, and the National Postsecondary Education Cooperative; and

WHEREAS, Chancellor Risser is the first Chancellor for Higher Education to have held the presidency of two national universities; and

WHEREAS, Chancellor Risser has led a public agenda to address Oklahoma's need for better prepared students, more college graduates and a well-developed work force through initiatives that include cooperative alliance with career technology centers, a statewide accelerated adult degree completion program and a web-based student information portal; and

WHEREAS, Chancellor Risser has developed partnerships with the Department of Commerce, the Department of Career and Technology Education and the Employment Security Commission to address economic development and work force needs in Oklahoma.
