A Resolution honoring the Native American Tribes for their contributions to fire departments, firefighters and the State of Oklahoma; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Native American Tribes in Oklahoma have donated money to the rural fire departments and firefighters in the State of Oklahoma to help in the burn-ban crisis; and

WHEREAS, the Native American Tribes have donated in-kind services to help rural fire departments and firefighters of their communities and counties; and

WHEREAS, the Native American Tribes have opened their doors and provided food, shelter and water for rural fire departments and firefighters during their long nights keeping counties and the State of Oklahoma safe from wildfires; and

WHEREAS, the Native American Tribes have worked hand-in-hand with those fire departments in their counties to acquire tankers, ladder trucks, pumpers, and other necessary fire-fighting tools; and

WHEREAS, the Native American Tribes are dedicated to the State of Oklahoma and the firefighters who struggle to save Oklahoma from wildfires.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 50TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives honors the Native American Tribes for their many generous contributions to Oklahoma and the rural fire departments.

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives recognizes the Native American Tribes for their dedication and commitment to preserving the State of Oklahoma and its lands and citizens.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to all the Native American Tribes in Oklahoma.
