THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives praises the Sam Noble Oklahoma Museum of Natural History for its efforts to expand our knowledge of the natural world around us by exhibiting the world-renowned T. Rex named Sue.

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives encourages its citizens to view these skeletal remains for the education they offer.
