An Act relating to Public Finance; amending 62 O.S. 2001, Section 275.1, as amended by Section 17, Chapter 224, O.S.L. 2003 (62 O.S. Supp. 2005, Section 275.1), which relates to records of certain warrants; clarifying language; deleting requirement to maintain certain warrants; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2001, Section 275.1, as amended by Section 17, Chapter 224, O.S.L. 2003 (62 O.S. Supp. 2005, Section 275.1), is amended to read as follows:

Section 275.1 All warrants issued by the ~~Oklahoma Public Welfare~~ Commission for Human Services and the State Treasurer, in payment of assistance to the needy, aged persons, blind or dependent children, shall be microfilmed or duplicated in a manner acceptable to the Archives and Records Commission, ~~by the Department of Human Services~~, provided further that the Department of Human Services is hereby authorized and directed to destroy said warrants, by burning, shredding, chemical process or any other method which will insure the complete destruction thereof, after microfilm or other copies are made thereof. ~~Permanent microfilm or other copies of the warrants shall be maintained by the Department of Human Services.~~ In addition to a possible earlier destruction schedule for warrants that have been duplicated satisfactorily, any redeemed warrant may be destroyed seven (7) years after it is redeemed with the permission of the Archives and Records Commission.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
