An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority, amending Sections 1 and 2 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 121 of the 1st Session of the 50th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority; modifying appropriation amounts; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA HEALTH CARE AUTHORITY

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 121 of the 1st Session of the 50th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, the sum of ~~Five Hundred Fifty-three Million Four Hundred Eighty-one Thousand eight Hundred Sixty-four~~ Five Hundred Forty Million Four Hundred Eighty-one Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-four Dollars ~~(\$553,481,864.00)~~ (\$540,481,864.00) or so much as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Health Care Authority by law.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 2 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 121 of the 1st Session of the 50th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of ~~Five Million Eighteen Million~~ Eighteen Million Dollars ~~(\$5,000,000.00)~~ (\$18,000,000.00) or so much as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Health Care Authority by law.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2005.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
