An Act relating to definitions and general provisions; designating the wild turkey *Meleagris gallopavo* as the state game bird; designating the dinosaur *Acrocanthosaurus atokensis* as the state dinosaur; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 98.13 of Title 25, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The wild turkey *Meleagris gallopavo* is hereby designated and adopted as the state game bird of the State of Oklahoma.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 98.14 of Title 25, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The dinosaur *Acrocanthosaurus atokensis* is hereby designated and adopted as the state dinosaur of Oklahoma.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
