An Act relating to the State Election Board;  
requiring budgeting in certain categories and  
amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
limiting the salary of the Secretary; and making  
appropriations nonfiscal.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007, the State Election Board shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

TOTAL	\$7,709,951.00	\$44,315,000.00

The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for each budget category.

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Election Board by law shall be set by the Secretary of the State Election Board. The salary of the Secretary of the State Election Board shall not exceed Seventy-nine Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$79,860.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007.

SECTION 3. Appropriations made by Section 11 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 80XX of the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 50th Oklahoma Legislature shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.
