An Act relating to corrections; requiring the Department of Corrections to reimburse counties certain amount for intermediate sanctions; setting amount of per diem; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 38.2 of Title 57, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Department of Corrections shall reimburse each county in an amount not to exceed Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) per offender per day for county jail incarceration that is ordered as an intermediate sanction for eligible offenders under the provisions of subsection B of Section 991b and subsection H of Section 991c of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2006.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
