An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority; directing a transfer; making an appropriation to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority; stating purpose; exempting certain funds from fiscal year limitations; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. TRANSFER The Director of State Finance shall transfer the sum of Fifty Million Dollars (\$50,000,000.00) from the "Oklahoma Health Care Authority Medicaid Program Fund" otherwise designated as Fund 340 within the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to the "Jobs and Growth Tax Relief Fund" otherwise designated as Fund 720 within the Office of State Finance.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, the sum of Fifty Million Dollars (\$50,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Health Care Authority by law.

SECTION 3. The appropriation made by Section 2 of this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the effective date of this act.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
