An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending  
21 O.S. 2001, Section 1740, which relates to the Pump  
Pirates Act; modifying penalty; and providing an  
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1740, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 1740. Any person who pumps gasoline into the gasoline  
tank of a vehicle and leaves the premises where the gasoline was  
pumped without making payment for the gasoline shall be guilty of a  
misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not  
more than ~~One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)~~ Five Hundred Dollars  
(\$500.00), or confinement in the county jail for a period of not  
more than sixty (60) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
